- 1) Lisa called meeting to order & welcomed group.
- 2) Adoption of last meeting's minutes (Motion to approved Michelle, Seconded Judy, Passed)
- 3) Administrator's Report
- Tony presented and reviewed the 2018 Gordon School Improvement Plan Literacy, Math, Grow-mind set. These are developed in connection to our area schools, the school board & ministry
- High-school open houses are happening throughout DSBN this week
- First week of January French Immersion Open House
- Last week of January Kindergarten Open House
- Gordon school Christmas Concert will be on Wednesday Dec. 18<sup>th</sup> at Centennial High School this year. Typical to expect 1100 people in audience. Big thank you to Miss. Stickles for coordinating the concert
- Kindergarten Concert and joy day will take place that morning in gym
- Playground is back in operation. Playground repairs and rototilling came in under budget @ \$3284.75
- New due to our large primary numbers we will utilize the front parking lot zone for inclement weather days. Pylons and new equipment for this have been purchased
- During winter freeze playground will be closed again pea gravel is unsafe when frozen
- School being wired for better wifi
- Salvation Army mitten tree and canned good drive will start shortly

### Question from parent to administration -

- Due to the switch from math instruction in French to English. She shared some concern about the overall amount of French instruction time and whether students would be meeting number of hours required for immersion bilingualism – Tony and Krista assured that because of grade 1 entry and changes across years for instruction that students will meet these requirements

- Tony and Krista discussed that they are balancing staff capabilities, French materials, and the new curriculum mandate. They are working on hiring teachers who can cover prep courses in French as well.

#### 4) Chair report

- We have a \$500 fund to "engage parents" from the ministry through the school board. In previous years we
  have combined these funds with the PRO grant to host Parent and Family Engagement Events
  - Barb motioned to use funds for evening event combined with STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math) event. Second by Allison. Passed.

### 5) Financial Report

Della Terra Fundraiser – 82 students participated – sold 408 bottles = \$1800 raised Vermeers – over 300 items sold - \$1353 raised
