Administrator's Report

School Council financial statement – current balance = \$9,348.73

These are school council funds as a result of school council funding such as fun fair

Gordon Playground Trust Account – current balance approx. \$10,000

- These funds are a result of board wide fundraising and has been gifted from school to parent council for a playground rebuild
- Currently playground is in good but declining condition

Kitchen update is being planned for this year. Current kitchen is original so approximately 75 years old. New stove, fridge, counters, & sinks are in the new plan

Niagara Nutrition Partners is currently offering fruit & snacks (yogurts, melba toast) 3 days/week at Gordon. The agency is interested in offering 5 days/week and a kitchen update will help ensure the snacks can be fresh or perishable. https://www.niagaranutritionpartners.ca/

10 trees were planted around school grounds in the Spring and all have survived the summer.

Pavement was repainted with purposely active and engaging games/activities. JK/SK are enjoying the extra space and active play. Gordon branding was used throughout.
