Chair Report

PRO Grant has now been approved. \$1000 approved for Gordon to host a First Nations/Indigenous culture event – learning for parents and youth. Another \$500 PRO funding has also been allocated to support school council more broadly.

Administrators Report

- French immersion open house had 22 families in attendance. Applications are open now.
- Next Thursday is full day kindergarten open house

- Third week of November the kitchen renovation started. Things are starting to wrap up now and should have snack program totally upgraded in about 2 weeks.
- Looking to move to a 5-day full day food program with the Niagara Nutrition
 Partners in future. Was suggested by administration that council could consider
 offering a long term commitment to the program with something like a 10%
 operating cost contribution.
- PRO grant evening is in development. Staff are working on speaker options.
